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CRP-Pashu Sakhi Policy

"A Participatory Peer Learning Approach to Enhancing Technical Competence, Innovation, and Advanced Goat Husbandry in Bihar"

A. Background / Introduction

The Pashu Sakhi Policy (Reference No. BRLPS/Project/463/13/Vol-II/795, dated 08/06/2018) mandates the engagement of Community Resource Persons (CRP-Pashu Sakhi) to systematically address the large-scale requirements of field-based technical training, handholding, and field-level support for Pashu Sakhis.

Goat-based livelihoods in Bihar have evolved into a proven, women-centric model that strengthens income generation and household economic resilience for resource-poor rural households. Under this intervention, JEEVIKA (BRLPS) has developed a cadre of trained women livestock service providers – Pashu Sakhis, who deliver essential animal health services and promote improved goat husbandry practices. Over 7,500 Pashu Sakhis currently serve more than 8 lakh households, constituting a robust community-based service ecosystem supporting goat-based livelihoods.

CRP-Pashu Sakhis will be deployed to address the growing demand among Pashu Sakhis for structured field-level technical training and improved service quality. They will provide coordinated technical guidance, continuous handholding support, and systematic oversight to ensure effective service delivery and sustained improvements in livestock management.

B. Role and Purpose of CRP-Pashu Sakhi

CRP-Pashu Sakhis will provide structured field-level training, technical support, and continuous guidance to Pashu Sakhis. Their primary role is to strengthen the adoption of improved goat-rearing practices, resolve field-level challenges, and ensure consistent service quality. By doing so, they will strengthen community-based livestock services and contribute to more sustainable goat-based livelihoods.

Expected Tasks of CRP-Pashu Sakhi

1. **Field-based Training & Technical Support** – Provide structured field-level training, technical guidance, and handholding support to Pashu Sakhis based on identified training needs.
2. **Technical Support in Goat Health Interventions** – Assist in key GHM interventions such as vaccination, deworming, castration, weight monitoring, primary aid, balanced nutrition, and ensure adherence to technical protocols.
3. **Strengthen Use of IEC & Training Tools** – Build the capacity of Pashu Sakhis to effectively use IEC materials, training tools, and demonstration methods.
4. **Data and Record Management Support** – Support accurate collection, validation, and updating of service-related data, including reporting through the PS app.

5. **Enhancing Community Coordination and Trust** – Facilitate effective coordination of Pashu Sakhi activities and strengthen their acceptance and credibility within SHGs, VOs, and the wider community.
6. **Promotion of Improved Goat Farming Practices** – Promote improved goat-rearing practices and facilitate their sustained adoption among households through Pashu Sakhis.
7. **Enterprise & Business Development Support** – Assist and guide Pashu Sakhis in strengthening their livestock enterprises through business planning, input management, product marketing, and improved market linkages to enhance income and enterprise growth.
8. **Performance Review & Activity Monitoring** – Support activity planning, performance monitoring, and review processes, and report inactive Pashu Sakhis to designated officials.

C. Eligibility & Selection Process

1. Eligibility Criteria

A candidate should preferably meet the following criteria to qualify as a CRP–Pashu Sakhi:

- Active Pashu Sakhi with completed GHM Phase–II training.
- Preferably serving at least 120 households for one year or more.
- Consistent average monthly earning of INR 3000 or more at least for over the last 3 months.
- Regularly practicing key GHM services such as vaccination, deworming, castration, health check-ups, and primary animal health care.
- Participation in a minimum of three vaccination and deworming campaigns.
- No reported complaints at SHG, VO, CLF, or community level.

2. Selection Process

- The LHS or Nodal Officer prepares a preliminary list of eligible candidates based on past performance and observations (**Annexure I**).
- Collects application forms from the identified candidates, along with the concerned VO's recommendation and approval (**Annexure II**).
- Shortlisted candidates undergo written and verbal interview, conducted by the BPM and the LHS or Nodal Officer, or other nominated official.
- The recommended list, along with copies of applications will be submitted to the DPM for approval.
- Upon approval, the selected candidates become eligible to enroll in the CRP–Pashu Sakhi training.

3. Exceptional Scenario for Existing CRP–Pashu Sakhis

- If any CRP–Pashu Sakhis have already been selected and have participated in activities such as orientation sessions or training or any drive, the BPM should preferably formalize their engagement by:
 - Submitting the list of such candidates along with copies of their approved application forms (**Annexure II**), and
 - Providing a formal declaration confirming and authenticating their selection as CRP–Pashu Sakhis for approval by the DPM, and informing the SPMU accordingly (**Annexure III**).

4. Discontinuation of CRP–Pashu Sakhi Engagement

- The BPM, in consultation with the Livestock Manager, may discontinue a CRP–Pashu Sakhi's engagement for poor performance, irregularity, or misconduct, and shall inform the DPCU and SPMU.
- A CRP–Pashu Sakhi can also voluntarily withdraw from the role by submitting a written request to the BPM, clearly stating the reasons for withdrawal.

D. CRP–Pashu Sakhi Training & Capacity Building

A three-day residential training will be conducted at the district level for newly selected CRPs.

Training Module Structure

1. Goat Health Management

- Hands-on training on vaccination, deworming, castration, nutrition, disease identification and management, primary treatment, goat housing, and marketing.

2. Pashu Sakhi Enterprise Development

- Orientation on the Pashu Sakhi business model: enterprise approach, business potential at household-level (for a 3-5 goat herd), income-enhancement strategies, and business planning.

3. Communication and Facilitation Skills

- Training on effective communication, community engagement, and facilitation techniques.

4. Record-Keeping and Reporting

- Training on the use of activity registers, progress reports, monitoring tools, and digital reporting (PS App).

5. Market Orientation

- Orientation on input and output markets, and market linkage opportunities.

6. Roles and Responsibilities of CRP–Pashu Sakhi

- Detailed briefing on CRP–Pashu Sakhi roles, responsibilities, training standards, and activity-based tasks.

7. Visioning and Long-Term Planning

- Visioning exercises to help CRPs understand long-term goals, expected outcomes, and their contribution to strengthening the livestock service ecosystem.

E. Operational Guideline and Management

1. Deployment Structure and Team Composition

- The BPM assigns CRP–Pashu Sakhis as individuals or in teams, depending on ground requirements and demand from Pashu Sakhis.
 - A CRP–Pashu Sakhi may work with 4–5 Pashu Sakhis and
 - A team of two may jointly support 8–10 Pashu Sakhis.
- Deployment of CRP–Pashu Sakhis is results-driven and guided by a clear action plan, informed by CRP support assessments (**Annexure IV**).
- CRP–Pashu Sakhis, as resources of BPIU and DPCU, are deployed and engaged to meet ongoing and future programme needs.

2. Logistical Support and Approvals

- The BPM ensures all necessary logistical arrangements (including conveying clear message to CMs and field team for their support) for effective field implementation.
- The BPM submits CRP deployment proposals to the DPM/authorised DPCU official for approval.
- The BPM and DPM will keep the SPMU informed of deployment plans and seek guidance as required.

3. Launching/Piloting of the CRP–Pashu Sakhi Initiative

- A six-day work plan for initiating the CRP–Pashu Sakhi drive is provided in **Annexure V**.

- BPIU/DPCU may adapt this plan during the launching/piloting phase based on block or district requirements and local field conditions.

4. Record-Keeping

- CRP–Pashu Sakhis must maintain daily activity records and submit reports in the prescribed formats (*Annexure VI*).

5. Field Monitoring, Review, and Coordination

- The LHS/Nodal Officer and BPM at the BPIU will provide regular field monitoring, technical support, and on-site guidance to the CRP–Pashu Sakhi team.
- To strengthen daily coordination, the BPM may assign one Community Coordinator (CC) to support the LHS/Nodal Officer. The designated CC will act as the key contact for field communication and facilitation of the CRP–Pashu Sakhi drive.
- Monthly reviews will be conducted at the BPIU level and quarterly reviews at the DPCU level to track progress, identify gaps, and plan corrective measures.
- Dedicated WhatsApp groups (block & district-level) will be established to streamline communication, share field updates, and enable timely feedback among CRP–Pashu Sakhis and officials.
- Under the supervision of the DPM and guidance of the SPMU, the Livestock Manager will coordinate between BPIU, DPCU, and SPMU, serving as the primary district-level focal point for the CRP–Pashu Sakhi drive.
- Progress reporting will adhere to JEEVIKA's standard protocols and any additional requirements issued by the SPMU.

6. CRP Pashu Sakhi Fees & Entitlements

CRP–Pashu Sakhis will be remunerated as per the provisions of the Pashu Sakhi Policy (Ref: BRLPS/Project/463/13/Vol-II/795) and the Internal CRP Policy (Ref: BRLPS/Project–M&E/1593/19/3259, dated 19/11/2025). Payments will be processed by the DPCU upon submission of the Resource Fee Claim Form, as prescribed in *Annexure VII*, along with the required supporting documents and the recommendations of the BPIU.

Terms and Conditions

- Food and Lodging Support: A CRP–Pashu Sakhi is entitled to food and lodging support as prescribed in the office order (Ref: BRLPS/Project–M&E/1593/19/3259, dated 19/11/2025).
- Food Allowance (Without Lodging): If lodging support is not availed, the CRP–Pashu Sakhi shall be entitled to a food allowance of ₹100 per day per person.
- Travel Support: The CRP–Pashu Sakhi is entitled to travel support as specified in the table above.

7. Provision for Medical Aids and Miscellaneous Expenditure

- Medical Aids & Equipment: CRP–Pashu Sakhi may purchase basic medical items (e.g., bandages, cotton, syringes, needles, antiseptic such as Betadine, gloves, etc.) as required.
- Reimbursement: Expenses for such items can be reimbursed by the concerned VO(s) aligned to the CRP–Pashu Sakhi, subject to the availability of miscellaneous funds as per office order (Ref: BRLPS/Proj-LS/463/13/4110, dated 26/03/2021).

Launching of the CRP–Pashu Sakhi Initiative

Proposed Six-Day Work Plan for CRP Pashu Sakhi

Step 1: Orientation & Planning (Day 1)

- Conduct an introductory meeting (preferably aligned with the Pashu Sakhi review meeting) involving the BPM, Livelihood Specialist/Nodal Officer, and, if required, the Livestock Manager.
- Review the field context, key priorities, and operational requirements to establish a common understanding.
- Assess the performance, challenges, and training needs of each Pashu Sakhi, and identify those requiring additional field training and handholding support.
- Prepare individual action plans for each Pashu Sakhi and consolidate them into an overall CRP–Pashu Sakhi activity plan (***Annexure IV***).

Step 2: Field Interventions & Technical Support (Day 2 & 3)

- Meet Pashu Sakhi(s) to understand field challenges, income levels, and training needs; reinforce GHM practices – on key aspects housing, health, nutrition, breeding, and marketing.
- Explain the Pashu Sakhi's business potential at the household level (for a 3–5 goat herd) using the prescribed worksheet.
- Demonstrate standard procedures, tools, and use of IEC materials through community meeting.
- Provide practical field-level technical training (e.g., vaccination, deworming, castration, etc.) during household visits.
- Support preparation of monthly activity plans and income-enhancement strategies.

Step 3: Follow-up & Capacity Strengthening (After 2–3 weeks / Day 4, 5 & 6)

- Review progress and identify operational gaps or challenges.
- Provide targeted on-site technical support and handholding based on identified gaps.
- Conduct household visits for hands-on demonstrations.
- Promote improved practices through meetings with women goat-rearers and community members.
- Assist Pashu Sakhis in preparing three-month business / activity plans and income-enhancement strategies.
- Provide remote guidance as required during the post-drive period.
